

CAMPGROUND RULES

- 1. All lot renters are required to have legible lot numbers affixed to their golf carts at all times.**
- 2. Speed limit is 5 miles per hour. This is strictly enforced. If caught exceeding the speed limit, the first time will be a warning and the second time will result in a two week suspension from the campground.**
- 3. Roads are all one way for vehicles. Golf carts may go both ways but must pull over and STOP for oncoming traffic.**
- 4. No one is permitted to STAND on golf carts, Occupants must be seated at all times. Do not exceed more than the required amount of people on the golf cart. Minimum age to drive a golf cart is 12 years old unless approved by Rian or Cheryl**
- 5. Take your trash and any items not being used for the year home with you. Anyone caught leaving trash in the campground, on the shoreline or in the river will be evicted.**
- 6. Children must be accompanied at all times by an adult when at the river. (All members are to use the river at their own risk, campground is NOT responsible for ANY swimming accidents) . The playground is for the use of all campground children. Please be responsible and have your children put their trash in the garbage cans provided.**
- 7. Use alcohol responsibly, only cans permitted at pavilion NO BOTTLES.**
- 8. YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE TO MAINTAIN YOUR LOT, Keep the grass, and possessions neat, any structure that is a safety hazard must be removed or repaired. Anything that is NOT being used at your lot take it home, please do not use your lot as a storage unit. PLEASE KEEP YOUR LOT AS CLEAN AS POSSIBLE. This will be enforced,**
- 9. Children under 12 must be supervised by an adult while at karaoke.**
- 10. You are not allowed to walk through anyone's lot without permission by the lot renter.**
- 11. If you have reason to leave the campground and want to sell your camper, that is OK. Lot rent will not pass on to anyone who buys your camper, they will have to sign a new contract before they move onto that site.**

12. If you need a camper moved around in the campground, there will be a fee of \$75.00
13. It is YOUR RESPONSIBILITY to monitor NOAA water level site for Hancock. If there is a flood, please come and move your camper. You may park your camper in the field until the water subsides. You are responsible for moving your camper to drier ground. Campground is not responsible for flood damage to your lot or camper.
14. Only one camper per lot, If you want an extra camper on your lot there will be an additional \$500.00 fee.
15. No four wheelers, dirt bikes or side by sides allowed at ANYTIME. Motorcycles are allowed at your campsite but no riding around the campground.
16. Dogs are welcome, they must be kept at your campsite or on a leash. No Dobermans or Rottweilers allowed.
17. You may have visitors at your campsite, but only if you are present or with advanced permission from owners of the campground if you are not present. A fee of \$15.00 will be charged for overnight visitors with a tent, and \$40.00 for a RV
18. Rian and Cheryl Orwig have the right to expel any campground member at any time for any outrageous behavior, and for not obeying campground rules. FIGHTING IS PROHIBITED AND WILL NOT BE TOLERATED! Lot rent will NOT BE REFUNDED.
19. Anything you put into the ground will be deemed part of the campground and will remain if you ever give up your lot. All additions must be approved by the campground owners Rian and Cheryl prior to you making them.
20. Gambling for your private gains in the campground is PROHIBITED
21. If you owe the campground owners money, you are PROHIBITED FROM ENTERING THE CAMPGROUND until it is PAID IN FULL.
22. QUIET TIMES ARE FROM 11pm to 8am. All children under the age of 18 must be back at your campsite by 11pm. Please be RESPECTFUL to your neighbors, as well as all campground members.
